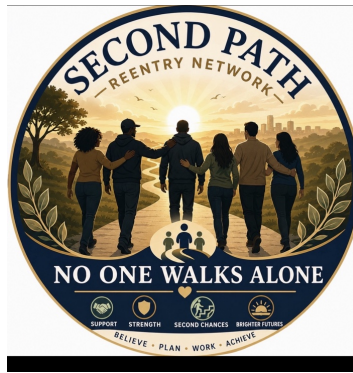




DOMESTIC VIOLENCE & SAFETY SUPPORT

Second Path Reentry Network recognizes that domestic violence can create serious barriers to safety, housing, employment, recovery, family stability, and successful reentry. We help individuals move toward a safer, more stable future with dignity, respect, and support.

- **Confidential Support & Screening:** A respectful opportunity for participants to identify safety concerns and immediate needs.
- **Safety Planning & Referrals:** Connections to trained domestic violence advocates and qualified community providers for individualized safety planning.
- **Emergency & Safe Housing Connections:** Help connecting with shelters, transitional housing, and other appropriate safe-housing resources.
- **Legal Resource Connections:** Referrals to organizations that can explain protective orders, victim advocacy, and other legal options.
- **Counseling & Recovery Support:** Connections to qualified counseling, trauma-informed services, recovery resources, and support groups when appropriate.
- **Practical Stabilization Support:** Coordination with Second Path services such as employment, transportation, clothing, self-care, identification documents, housing, and other reentry needs.

Our Role: Second Path Reentry Network provides support, resource navigation, and referrals. Specialized domestic violence counseling, legal advice, and emergency intervention are provided by appropriately trained or qualified partner organizations.
